Western Province recognizes Federalism on Peace Day

Western Province has marked the International Day of Peace in Gizo with the recognition that Federalism is the road to rebuilding peace and stability in Solomon Islands.

Team leader for Western Province Constitutional Congress Mr. Thornley Hite highlighted this during an official program organized by the Western Provincial Ministry of the Peace and Reconciliation on Monday 21st September 2015.

He said that the Federal/State Government system was one proposed since after independence and more so during the Buala Premiers' Peace Conference in 2000 during the time of ethnic unrest.
